This is the first step in the process of submitting a preprint to Emerging Research Information (EmeRI). Take a moment to read the terms carefully and then click on one of the buttons at the bottom of the page.

By not granting this license, you will not have access to the preprint description fields and will not be able to proceed with the deposit process

By accepting this license, you, the scientific editor, grant EmeRI the non-exclusive right to reproduce, translate, and/or distribute the preprint, in any medium or format (printed or electronic, including audio or video).

You agree that EmeRI may, without altering the content, transpose the preprint to any medium or format for preservation purposes, as well as keep more than one copy for security, back-up and preservation purposes. You declare that the work is original and that you are authorized to grant the rights contained in this license.

If the preprint contains material that you do not own the copyright to, you declare that you have obtained the necessary permission of the holder(s) of these rights to grant them to EmeRI and that this material owned by third parties is clearly identified and recognized in the text or the content of the file now deposited.

If the research that gave rise to the preprint has been sponsored or supported by a development agency or similar organization, you declare that you have respected any and all revision rights, as well as other obligations required by contract or agreement.
